It was our great honor to welcome Dr. Steve Chen to speak with our Secondary students this week. Walking the students through a career in computer engineering that spans over five decades, Dr. Chen shared the impact of supercomputing on our modern world and his vision for where these technologies will take us next.

Dr. Chen first came to the world's attention in the mid-1980s with the innovative design of supercomputer technologies. His development of a 128 blade parallel vector supercomputer was widely adopted across automotive, air travel, energy, and other industries, driving their research and development ahead at speeds the world could barely imagine.


Today, Dr. Chen is the founder and President of the Third Brain Research Institute which explores the relationship between the human brain and the capacity of technology the algorithms of artificial intelligence. Dr. Chen shared how science is progressing in the field of brain research and how each month brings new insights into diseases such as Alzheimer's and Parkinson's.

This was a rare opportunity and an incredible session that triggered every student's curiosity, giving rise to new questions, new directions, and new thinking. And now it's the students turn to take these big ideas and challenges and shape the innovations of the coming decades!

Business Simulation in Guangzhou

About 320 students coming from 20 schools in the Guangzhou region, competed to be in the top 60% to enter the All-star Competition. The event kicked off with an **auction** that required students to respond quickly and have a clear strategic target. The transactions that followed asked students to negotiate with other companies efficiently and reasonably.

The operations offered students many business indicators to consider, and students calculated based on designed rules to make the maximum profits. The first presentation (**Business Plan**) focused on the product design and business strategy, and the second presentation (**Business Battle**) was more about the corporate culture, with Gender Equality as the theme.

The Business Battle, in which students only had one night to prepare, contained Q&A activities which required students to develop good questions

and deliver fast answers. In this part, both ZIS teams won 1st prize in their category and received 3 million RMB as a virtual bonus for operations.

This competition gave students a chance to practice their collaborative skills, challenge their personalities, manage time, and work efficiently. Grasping the key information, exhibiting strong analytical ability and finishing tasks in a timely manner led to success in the competition. Our students showed their advantage in critical thinking, communication, and collaboration. Information literacy, creative thinking, and reflection are what they learn in class and contribute to students' lifelong learning in the future, not only for students in business but for all majors.


