Dongguan over the past weekend, playing three matches against other Pearl River Conference schools on Saturday, Sep 24th.

In the first match ZIS turned around an unfortunate early deflected goal against to roar back from behind to a 9-1 victory against UISZ. Goals from Biel, Jelle, Zandermine, and Theo paced the team, with big contributions on defense from Mikail and Keane, supported by a stout goalkeeping performance by Aditya.

Leg 2 saw a more competitive match against one of the stronger teams in the group Tsinglan. ZIS fell behind 1-0 only to tie it with a blistering shot by Biel before halftime. In the second half it was a great back and forth battle, with a second goal scored late in the match by TS. During the summer vacation, I participated in the Amplify Trading International Financial Market Analyst Internship. I gained a great deal of knowledge and experience during the internship. In addition to gaining financial knowledge during the internship, what impressed me the most was creating a macroeconomic report based on the economic trend of the US in English with the group. By locating sources and researching the causes of the weak economy in the US, the study was completed. In the process, I came to understand that creating a report needs not only gathering data and researching economic trends, but also paying attention to the logic of organizing the content in order to produce a reasonable and reliable result. I enhanced the report and practiced my English-speaking skills during the final week of the internship using the information investigated. 

Considering the data collected from the events that happened in the recent 5 years, the prediction of the unemployment rate in the United States may likely increase.




GDP Growth Rate


Following a guarterly decline of 1.6% in OI, the U.S. economy contracted guarterly by an annualized 0.9% in Q2 2022, officially entering a recession. The main obstacles were various types of corporate investments. (Investments in housing, building construction machinery, etc.) Throughout this time, PCE rose slowly while spending on commodities and government consumption decreased.



The unemployment rate may rise to a small extent is stated by looking at the graph about the employment status of the nation in recent years. The U.S. non-farm employment data graph has shown that the employment rate is decreasing in the first quarter of the year. In addition, the PMI employment rate is also decreasing recently.
