BUILDING CURIOSITY THROUGH A MUSEUM TRIP

Many people feel instinctively that there is value to a museum field trip but struggle to articulate exactly what it is. It's good for kids to get out of the classroom a couple of times a year. It's good for them to see knowledge at work in the real world.

Year 2 class went to the Zhuhai Museum last Wednesday for the UOI – *Where we are in place and time*, and this provided the students with the opportunity to understand the history of Zhuhai. Year twos had to learn about the rules in a museum beforehand and how to take care of the art/display by showing respect while visiting a museum. They became inquirers and more knowledgeable by asking questions about what was displayed inside of the Zhuhai Museum and answering questions provided by the teachers. Students had to find the answers within the museum and reflected on their answers in class after the field trip.

Field trips to museums have enormous benefits and for curious students to explore an ancient world they have never seen before. Museums also provide students with experiences connecting them to their cultural heritage, to beauty, and to thought-provoking works of art is one clear way museums provide value to society.
